New Slovakia (difficult) birth of the modern lifestyle 1918 - 1949

Next Thursday Art Talk will focus on the exhibition New Slovakia, which shows the penetration of modern civilization into Slovak society from 1918 to 1948/49. The picture of modernizing Slovakia as it was captured by visual arts, architecture and design is the key theme. Modern life was only a marginal theme within the framework of the Slovak art of this period. The expressions of modern life in a countryside practically devoid of industry, with prevailing rural population, were manifested gradually, slowly and frequently in a contradictory context.
